BY-LAW No. 139-1998

To amend former City of Toronto By-law No. 1995-0194, being "A By-law To declare real property to be surplus to the needs of the City", respecting 35 and 37 Hazelton Avenue.

WHEREAS under the *Municipal Act*, the sale of a highway, road or road allowance is exempt from the requirement to obtain an appraisal of the fair market value of the property;
