BY-LAW No. 211-1998

To amend further By-law No. 92-93, a by-law "To regulate traffic on roads in the Borough of East York", being a by-law of the former Borough of East York.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule XX of By-law No. 92-93, a By-law "To regulate traffic on roads in the Borough of East York" as amended, being a by-law of the former Borough of East York, is further amended by striking out the following words where they appear in Columns 1 and 2 of the said Schedule:

Column 1
Intersections

Column 2
Yield Streets

At MacNaughton Road and Cameron Crescent On Cameron Crescent

2. That Schedule XIX of said By-law No. 92-93 as amended, being a by-law of the former Borough of East York, is further amended by inserting in Columns 1 and 2 of the said Schedule, between the words "Burrel Avenue and King Edward Avenue" and the words "Cameron Crescent and Sharron Drive" where they appear in Column 1 of the said Schedule, the following:

Column 1
Intersections

Column 2
Stop Streets

Cameron Crescent and MacNaughtan Road On Cameron Crescent west of
MacNaughtan Road

3. This by-law shall come into force on the date of its enactment.
