CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 214-1998

**To appoint and delineate certain duties and responsibilities of the
Commissioner responsible for economic development, culture and tourism.**

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

- 1.** Joseph A. Halstead is hereby appointed Commissioner responsible for economic development, culture and tourism (the "Commissioner") for a term expiring 3 years from the date this by-law comes into force.
- 2.** The Commissioner shall be responsible for the direction and control of all departmental and organizational units responsible for providing economic development, culture and tourism.
- 3.** The Commissioner shall carry out such additional duties and exercise such additional responsibilities as Council may from time to time prescribe.
- 4.** Where this by-law conflicts with the provisions of any other by-law setting out the powers and duties of a municipal official, this by-law prevails to the extent of the conflict.
- 5.** This by-law shall come into force on the date of its enactment.
