## BY-LAW No. 221-1998

## To amend further Metropolitan By-law No. 32-92, respecting the regulation of traffic on former Metropolitan Roads.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

**1.** Schedule XI (No Standing) of Metropolitan By-law No. 32-92, as amended, is further amended by striking out the words and figures:

Dundas Street South A point 117 metres east of Anytime

West Beverley Street and a point (M.T. 8) 20 metres further east

thereof

where they occur opposite each other in Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the said Schedule and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

Dundas Street South Beverley Street and McCaul 9:30 a.m. to 10:30 p.m. West Street

(M.T. 8)

2. This By-law shall be effective commencing June 10, 1998.
