- **2.** Amendments to By-law No. 14402, the Malvern Community By-law:
  - 2.1 Schedule "A" is amended by adding the land shown outlined on Schedule "1" together with the following:

2.2 Schedule "B" **PERFORMANCE STANDARD CHART**, is amended by adding Performance Standard 70:

## **INTENSITY OF USE**

70. Maximum one **dwelling unit** per parcel having a minimum frontage of 7.5 m on a **public street** and a minimum lot area of 340 m<sup>2</sup>.
