CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 241-1998

To amend By-law No. 1997-0270, as amended, to extend the period of interim control on certain lands known municipally as 16 Avondale Road.

WHEREAS the Council of the former City of Toronto, at its meeting held on June 2 and 3, 1997, passed Interim Control By-law No. 1997-0270, prohibiting the erection of any building or structure within the lands municipally known as 16 Avondale Road; and

WHEREAS Section 38(2) of the Planning Act permits the council of a municipality to pass a by-law amending an interim control by-law to extend the period of time in which the interim control will be in effect to a period not exceeding two years;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. By-law No. 1997-0270, being "A By-law to effect interim control on certain lands known municipally as 16 Avondale Road", is hereby further amended by deleting from Section 2, the words "one year" and substituting therefor the words "two years".
