## BY-LAW No. 246-1998

To amend By-law No. 1997-0403 being a by-law to further amend former City of Toronto

By-law No. 602-89, being "A By-law To authorize the construction, widening, narrowing,

alteration and repair of sidewalks, pavements and curbs at various locations", respecting the alteration of Scarborough Road by the narrowing of the pavement on the west side of Scarborough Road near Woodale Avenue.

The Council of The City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:
