BY-LAW No. 251-1998

To further amend former City of Toronto By-law No. 602-89, being "A By-law To authorize the construction, widening, narrowing, alteration and repair of sidewalks, pavements and curbs at various locations", respecting the alteration of Glengrove Avenue West by the installation of speed humps from Yonge Street to Avenue Road.

WHEREAS notice of a proposed By-law regarding the proposed alteration was published in a daily newspaper on April 14, 21, 28 and May 5, 1998 and interested persons were given an opportunity to be heard at a public meeting held on May 6, 1998 and it is appropriate to amend the by-law to permit the alteration.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Former City of Toronto By-law No. 602-89, being "A By-law To authorize the construction, widening, narrowing, alteration and repair of sidewalks, pavements and curbs at various locations", is amended by inserting in Columns 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6, respectively, of Schedule "B-4" (Pavement Alteration/Repair) the following:
