CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 296-1998

To amend City of York By-law No. 196-84, being a By-law “To regulate traffic on City of York Roads.”

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

NO STOPPING - SCHEDULE IX

1. THAT Schedule IX of City of York By-law No. 196-84, as amended, be further amended by deleting in Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of said Schedule the following:

Column 1	Column 2	Column 3	Column 4
<u>Highway</u>	<u>Side</u>	<u>Between</u>	<u>Prohibited Times or Days</u>
George Street	west	King Street and a point 96 metres north thereof	Anytime
George Street	east	A point 58 metres north King Street to a point 102 metres north thereof	Anytime

NO STOPPING - SCHEDULE IX

2. THAT Schedule IX of City of York By-law No. 196-84, as amended, be further amended by inserting in Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of said Schedule the following:

Column 1	Column 2	Column 3	Column 4
<u>Highway</u>	<u>Side</u>	<u>Between</u>	<u>Prohibited Times or Days</u>
George Street	east	King Street and a point 57.9 metres north thereof	Anytime
George Street	west	A point 91.4 metres north King Street and a point 61.6 metres north thereof	Anytime

3. THAT Schedule XIX of City of York By-law No. 196-84, as amended, be further amended by inserting in Columns 1 and 2 of the said Schedule the following:

King Street for east and westbound traffic
