BY-LAW No. 309-1998

To amend By-law No. 61-95 of the former Municipality of Metropolitan Toronto which delegates certain authority in relation to planning matters.

WHEREAS By-law No. 61-95 of the former Municipality of Metropolitan Toronto delegated to the Metropolitan Commissioner of Planning the authority to approve applications for approval of a plan of condominium; and

WHEREAS it is desirable for City Council to exercise this approval function with respect to applications to convert rental units to condominium units;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. By-law No. 61-95 of the former Municipality of Metropolitan Toronto is hereby amended by adding the following subsection 3(3):

Commencing the date that the Tenant Protection Act, 1997 comes into force, the power delegated to the Commissioner by section 2 shall not include the authority to make decisions on applications which involve the conversion of rental housing to condominium.
