CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 310-1998

To authorize an agreement with The Consumers Gas Company Limited to permit the use of certain abandoned (decommissioned) gas mains located within the highways of the municipality for refurbishing and use as conduit structures for fibre optic cable.

WHEREAS City Council, at its meeting of June 3, 4 and 5, 1998, approved the entering into of an agreement with The Consumers Gas Company Limited to permit the refurbishing and use of certain abandoned (decommissioned) gas mains within the public highways for the purposes of a conduit structure for fibre optic cable; and

WHEREAS City Council, pursuant to the *Municipal Act* and the *City of Toronto Act, 1972* (No. 2), is authorized to enter into agreements with persons upon such terms and conditions as may be agreed in respect of the refurbishing and use of ducts or conduits under the public highway in which telecommunications equipment may be installed in the public highway and require the payment of charges for the privilege;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The Agreement with The Consumers Gas Company Limited to permit the refurbishing and use of abandoned (decommissioned) gas mains within the public highways under the jurisdiction of the City of Toronto for the purposes of a conduit structure for fibre optic cable, is hereby authorized.

2. All documents required to be signed on behalf of the Corporation in respect of the Agreement hereby authorized shall be signed by the Chief Financial Officer and City Treasurer or designate and the City Clerk or designate, and the City Clerk or designate are hereby authorized and directed to affix the seal of the Corporation to all such documents.
