## BY-LAW No. 313-1998

To stop up, close and sell Part of Borough Drive between Progress Avenue and Town Centre Court.

WHEREAS the Council of the former City of Scarborough deems it expedient to stop up, close and sell Part of Borough Drive between Progress Avenue and Town Centre Court registered in the Land Titles Division of Toronto and more particularly described in Schedule "A" attached hereto; and

The Council of The City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

- 1. THAT that Part of Borough Drive between Progress Avenue and Town Centre Court is hereby stopped up and closed, in accordance with the provisions of The Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter M.45, as amended.
- **2.** THAT the Mayor and Clerk are authorized and empowered on behalf of the City of Toronto to execute all necessary documents to give effect hereto and to affix the seal of the City hereto.
