**CITY OF TORONTO**

**BY-LAW No. 367-1998**

**To amend By-law No. 1995-0194, being a “By-law To declare real property to be surplus to the needs of the City”, respecting part of the public highway Sudbury Street and 20 Sudbury Street.**

WHEREAS Council, at its meeting of June 3, 4 and 5, 1998, adopted Clause 26 of Corporate Services Committee Report No. 7, and recommended that By-law No. 1995-0194, being “A By-law To declare real property to be surplus to the needs of the City”, be further amended; and

WHEREAS an appraisal of the current market value of the site has been completed;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

**1.** By-law 1995-0194, being “A By-law To declare real property to be surplus to the needs of the City”, is amended by inserting in columns 1 and 2 respectively, of Schedule “A” (Surplus Property) the following:
