BY-LAW No. 370-1998

To authorize certain works and undertakings on City of Toronto Roads.

WHEREAS notice of this by-law has been published and the provisions of the Municipal Act relating to the altering of highways have been complied with:

Now, therefore, the Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The following works and undertakings, as described in the following table:

	Location	Work and Undertaking
(1)	Queen's Park Crescent, 80 metres north of College Street	Construct traffic island;
(2)	Steeles Avenue East at Bestview Drive	Construct a pedestrian refuge island;
(3)	Sheppard Avenue East, 50 metres east of Allanford Road	Construct a pedestrian refuge island;
(4)	McCowan Road at Bridley Drive/Big Red Avenue	Construct a pedestrian refuge island;
(5)	Eglinton Avenue West at Renforth drive	Relocate a westbound TTC stop to channelling island;
(6)	Trethewey Drive and Yore Road (North of Eglinton Avenue West and between Keele Street)	Remove existing traffic island and realign curbs;
(7)	Queen's Park at Royal Ontario Museum	Extend existing bus bay;
(8)	Lake Shore Boulevard West, 80 metres east of Ellis Avenue	Construct a "U"- turn channel across median;
(9)	3600 Danforth Avenue, east of Wolcott Avenue	Construct a median break;

(10) Sheppard Avenue West at Laura Road Construct a pedestrian refuge island; and

(11) Bayview Avenue at Nesbitt Drive Construct a northbound left turn lane.
