CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 371-1998

To authorize certain works and undertakings on City of Toronto Roads.

WHEREAS notice of this by-law has been published and the provisions of the Municipal Act relating to the altering of highways have been complied with:

Now, therefore, the Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. The following works and undertakings, as described in the following table:

Location Work and Undertaking Construct an extension of the (1) Islington Avenue at Albion Road southbound traffic island: Construction of development (2) 800 Warden Avenue, south of Civic Road accesses, concrete centre medians, a southbound right turn lane and traffic control signals; (3) Morningside Avenue at Ellesmere Road Construct an extension of the southbound traffic island; (4) 740 Ellesmere Road, east of Construction of a development Birchmount Road access; Construct an eastbound right-turn Ellesmere Road, at Kennedy Road lane; Warden Avenue, at Ellesmere Road Construct a southbound right-turn lane; Reconstruction of centre median and (5) The Queensway, west of The West Mall widening of south side to provide for an eastbound right turn lane;

Location

Work and Undertaking

Reconstruction of the concrete centre median to provide a westbound left turn lane into the Queens Walk Developments;

Installation of traffic control signals at the intersection of The Queensway and the entrance to the Queens Walk Development, west of The West Mall;

The West Mall, south of The Queensway

Reconstruction of centre median to accommodate an extension of the northbound left turn lane; and

(6) Overlea Boulevard at William Morgan Drive

Reconstruction of centre medians to accommodate the installation of traffic control signals.
