CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 414-1998

To amend the former City of Toronto Municipal Code Ch. 400, Traffic and Parking, respecting Simcoe Street.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 400, Traffic and Parking, of the former City of Toronto is amended as follows:

A. By inserting in Schedule I (One Way Highways), the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1)	(In Column 2)	(In Column 3)	(In Column 4)
Simcoe Street (east/west branch)	Entire length	Anytime	From west to east

B. By inserting in Schedule XVI (Speed limits on Highways), the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1)	(In Column 2)	(In Column 3)
Simcoe Street (east/west branch)	40	Simcoe Street and St. Patrick Street

C. By inserting in Schedule IV (Stop Intersection), the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1)	(In Column 2)
Simcoe Street (east/west branch) and Simcoe Street (north/south branch)	Simcoe Street (east/west branch)
Simcoe Street (north/south branch) and Simcoe Street (east/west branch)	Simcoe Street (north/south branch)

D. By inserting in Schedule XXIII (No parking certain times), the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1)	(In Column 2)	(In Column 3)	(In Column 4)
Simcoe Street (east/west branch)	Both	Simcoe Street (north/south branch) and St. Patrick Street	Anytime

2. Section 1 of this By-law does not come into effect until the conveyances to the City of the lands described in Section 1 and the necessary land registrations respecting those conveyances are completed.
