BY-LAW No. 429-1998

**To amend By-law No. 92-93, a by-law “To regulate traffic on roads
in the Borough of East York”, being a by-law of the former Borough of East York.**

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule XX of By-law No. 92-93, a By-law “To regulate traffic on roads in the Borough of East York” as amended, being a by-law of the former Borough of East York, is further amended by striking out the following words where they appear in Columns 1 and 2 of the said Schedule:

Column 1
Intersections

At Squires Avenue

At Squires Avenue

Column 2
Yield Streets

On the southerly intersection of Furnival
Road

On the northerly intersection of Furnival
Road

2. That Schedule XIX of said By-law No. 92-93 as amended, being a by-law of the former Borough of East York, is further amended by inserting in Columns 1 and 2 of the said Schedule, between the words “Floyd Avenue and Woodycrest Avenue” and “Gamble Avenue and Todmorden Lane” where they appear in Column 1 of the said Schedule, the following:

Column 1
Intersections

Furnival Road and Squires Avenue

Furnival Road and Squires Avenue

Column 2
Stop Streets

on Furnival Road east of Squires Avenue

on Furnival Road west of Squires Avenue

3. This by-law shall come into force on the date of its enactment.
