**CITY OF TORONTO**

**BY-LAW No. 432-1998**

**To amend By-law No. 92-93, a by-law “To regulate traffic on roads in the Borough of East York”, being a by-law of the former Borough of East York.**

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

**1.** Schedule XVIII of By-law No. 92-93, a By-law “To regulate traffic on roads in the Borough of East York” as amended, being a by-law of the former Borough of East York, is further amended by striking out the following words where they appear in Columns 1 and 2 of the said Schedule:

Column 1 Road	Column 2 Between
Sammon Avenue	Dewhurst Boulevard and Woodbine Avenue except at its intersection with Donlands Avenue, Inwood Avenue, Greenwood Avenue, Linsmore Crescent, Coxwell Avenue, and Woodmount Avenue

**2.** Schedule XVIII of said By-law No. 92-93 a By-law “To regulate traffic on roads in the Borough of East York” as amended, being a by-law of the former Borough of East York, is further amended by inserting in Columns 1 and 2 of the said Schedule, between the words “Sammon Avenue”, “Pape Avenue and Dewhurst Boulevard” and “Sammon Avenue”, “Woodbine Avenue and Cedarvale Avenue” where they appear in Columns 1 and 2 of the said Schedule, the following:

Column 1 Road	Column 2 Between
Sammon Avenue	Dewhurst Boulevard and Woodbine Avenue except at its intersection with Donlands Avenue, Inwood Avenue, Greenwood Avenue, Linsmore Crescent, Coxwell Avenue, Glebemount Avenue, and Woodmount Avenue

**3.** This by-law shall come into force on the date of its enactment.
