A by-law to provide for the use of vote-counting machines in respect of the by-election to be held in Ward 1 - East York on September 24th, 1998.

WHEREAS, Section 42 of the Municipal Elections Act, S.O. 1996 provides that a municipal council may at least sixty days prior to voting day, pass a by-law authorizing the use of voting and vote-counting equipment (or alternative voting methods);

1. The use of vote-counting equipment is hereby authorized in respect of the by-election to be held for the position of Councillor Ward 1 - East York.
