The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. THAT Section 50(5) of the Planning Act R.S.O. 1990 shall not apply to the lands identified within Registered Plan 66M-2292 as follows:

Lots 134-141, 143-159, 161-168, 432, 433, 435-437, 439-445, 460, 461 463 and 469.

such approval shall be conditional upon the Commissioner of Planning and Buildings approval of the reference plan(s) prior to plan(s) being deposited in the Land Registry Office.

2. AND THAT this By-law shall be in effect for 12 months from the date of passage by Council.
