CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 535-1998

To provide for the entering into of easements for the conservation of buildings on lands known as Nos. 363 and 365 Adelaide Street East and 226 King Street East.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

- 1. The entering into of an easement with the owner or owners of lands known as Nos. 363 and 365 Adelaide Street East, being of historic and architectural value or interest, is hereby authorized.
- 2. The entering into of an easement with the owner or owners of lands known as No.226 King Street East, being of architectural value or interest, is hereby authorized.
- **3.** All documents required to be signed on behalf of the City in respect to the easements hereby authorized shall be signed by the City Clerk and the Chief Financial Officer and Treasurer, who are hereby authorized and directed to affix the seal of the City to all such documents.
