**CITY OF TORONTO**

**BY-LAW No. 560-1998**

**To amend By-law No. 28-1998, being  
“A By-law respecting the ‘Toronto Parking Authority’”,  
to facilitate the transfer of parking operations.**

WHEREAS, by the *City of Toronto Act, 1997 (No. 2)* and the *Municipal Act*, the Council of the City may delegate to the Toronto Parking Authority the construction, maintenance, operation and management of parking operations and facilities; and

WHEREAS City Council has directed that the responsibility for off-street municipal parking facilities and on-street metered parking operations within the former Metro and Area municipalities shall be transferred from City staff and delegated to the Toronto Parking Authority;

The Council of The City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

**1.** By-law No. 28-1998, being “A By-law respecting the ‘Toronto Parking Authority’” is amended by:

(1) Adding to section 7 the following clauses:

- (c) Except as provided in clause (d), only City Council shall pass by-laws for the purposes of regulating the installation and operation of on-street parking meters, including the setting of rates for such meters.
- (d) The Parking Authority shall be authorized to fix rates for on-street parking meters provided that such rates do not exceed \$2.00 per hour and have been agreed to by the Ward Councillors and the Community Council for the Ward in which the parking meters are located.
