BY-LAW No. 565-1998

**To amend further Metropolitan By-law No. 62-91,
respecting reserved lanes for bicycles on certain former Metropolitan Roads.**

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule "A" to Metropolitan By-law No. 62-91, being a By-law "To provide reserved lanes for bicycles on certain former Metropolitan Roads", as amended, is amended by inserting the following words and figures in Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the said Schedule:

Lake Shore Boulevard (M.T. 2)	Fortieth Street and Thirty-First Street	Southerly Eastbound	Anytime
