CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 574-1998

**To dedicate the lane extending easterly from the public lane
36.6 metres east of Indian Road Crescent at the rear of premises
25 to 31 Annette Street for public lane purposes.**

WHEREAS the lands to be dedicated were laid out by former City of Toronto By-law No. 1997-0444 and the date of possession by the City was April 3, 1998;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Certain land to form part of the lane extending easterly from the public lane 36.6 metres east of Indian Road Crescent at the rear of premises 25 to 31 Annette Street, described by W. Kowalenko, O.L.S., City Surveyor, as follows, namely:

All of Parcel Plan-1 in the Register for Section 66D-1029.

Being PARTS 1 and 2 on Expropriation Plan 66D-1029 registered in the Land Registry Office for the Land Titles Division of Metropolitan Toronto (No. 66).

In the City of Toronto and Province of Ontario.

is dedicated for public lane purposes.
