## BY-LAW No. 576-1998

1. Certain land being the public lane west of John Street, extending southerly from Stephanie Street, described by W. Kowalenko, O.L.S., City Surveyor, as follows, namely:

In the City of Toronto and Province of Ontario, being composed of;

FIRSTLY: (Land Titles Office)

The Remainder of Parcel 13-21 in the Register for Section Y-2.

Being the Public Lane dedicated by City of Toronto By-law 480-89 (C584966), being part of Park Lot 13 in Concession 1 from the Bay in the Geographic Township of York also known as Lots 6 and 7 on Boulton's Unregistered Plan designated as PART 1 on Plan 66R-15030 deposited in the Land Registry Office for the Land Titles Division of Metropolitan Toronto (No. 66).

The southerly limit of Stephanie Street as confirmed under the Boundaries Act by Plan BA-1157 (A687875).
