BY-LAW No. 577-1998

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

In the City of Toronto and Province of Ontario, being composed of parts of Lots 4, 5, 6, 7, 8 and 9 on Plan 367, parts of Lots II, III, IV and V on Plan 945, parts of Lots C and D on Plan 911, and part of Lot 10 on Plan 737, designated as PARTS 1 to 10, inclusive, on Expropriation Plan 12132 (CA512976), all of the said Plans being registered in the Land Registry Office for the Metropolitan Toronto Registry Division (No. 64).

is dedicated for public lane purposes.
