BY-LAW No. 590-1998

**To further amend former City of Toronto By-law No. 602-89,
being "A By-law To authorize the construction, widening, narrowing, alteration
and repair of sidewalks, pavements and curbs at various locations", respecting
the alteration of Palmerston Avenue by narrowing the pavement
from Bloor Street West to north of Bloor Street West.**

WHEREAS notice of a proposed By-law regarding the proposed alteration was published in a daily newspaper on June 30, July 7, 14 and July 21, 1998 and interested persons were given an opportunity to be heard at a public meeting held on July 22, 1998 and it is appropriate to amend the by-law to permit the alteration;

The Council of The City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Former City of Toronto By-law No. 602-89, being "A By-law To authorize the construction, widening, narrowing, alteration and repair of sidewalks, pavements and curbs at various locations", is amended:

(1) by inserting in Columns 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6, respectively, of Schedule "B-3" (Pavement Narrowing) the following:

Palmerston Avenue	east	from: 7.28 m to: 5.5 m - 7.28 m	Bloor Street West	11 m north of Bloor Street West	SK-2194 dated April, 1998
