CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 611-1998

To appoint tax collectors for the City of Toronto and to rescind former appointments.

WHEREAS by Section 85(1) of the Municipal Act requires the council of every local municipality to appoint as many collectors for the municipality as it considers necessary; and

WHEREAS Sections 391, 407, 408 and 432 of the Municipal Act set out the duties of collectors of taxes; and

WHEREAS Council at its meeting of July 29, 30 and 31, 1998, resolved that Margo Lynd Brunning, Giuliana Carbone and Robert Ripley be appointed collectors of taxes for the municipality;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

- 1. Margo Lynd Brunning, Giuliana Carbone and Robert Ripley are hereby appointed as collectors of taxes for the whole of the City of Toronto.
- 2. In addition to all duties imposed upon a collector by the Municipal Act and any other statutes and all amendments thereto, and by any by-law of the Council, the collectors appointed pursuant to this by-law shall perform such related duties as assigned to them by the Chief Financial Officer and Treasurer for the City of Toronto.
- **3.** By-laws appointing collectors of taxes for the former Cities of Etobicoke, North York, Scarborough, Toronto and York and the Borough of East York are hereby repealed.
 - **4.** This by-law shall come into force on the day on which it is enacted.
