BY-LAW No. 633-1998

To authorize the alteration of Ava Road and Winnett Avenue in the City of York.

The Council of the City of Toronto hereby ENACTS as follows:

1. That the alteration of the intersection of Ava Road with Winnett Avenue in the City of Toronto (formerly the City of York) by raising the pedestrian walkway crossing the east, west, north, and south approaches to the intersection as shown on the drawing attached as Schedule "A" to this By-law to a maximum height of 100 mm, be and the same is hereby authorized.
