BY-LAW No. 685-1998

**To amend further Metropolitan By-law No. 32-92, respecting
the regulation of traffic on former Metropolitan Roads.**

The Council of The City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule XIII (One-Way Traffic Lanes) of Metropolitan By-law No. 32-92, as amended, is further amended by inserting the following words and figures in Columns 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 of the said Schedule:

(In Column 1)	(In Column 2)	(In Column 3)	(In Column 4)	(In Column 5)
Morningside Avenue and Finch Avenue East/Old Finch Avenue	Finch Avenue East/Old Finch Avenue and a point 30.5 metres south thereof	Easterly Northbound	Anytime	Northbound right-turning (buses excepted)

2. Schedule XV (Prohibited Turns) of Metropolitan By-law No. 32-92, as amended, is further amended by inserting the following words and figures in Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the said Schedule:

(In Column 1)	(In Column 2)	(In Column 3)	(In Column 4)
Warden Avenue and the northerly access to No. 800 Warden Avenue, located 190 metres south of Eglinton Avenue East (M.T. 67)	Eastbound and Northbound	Left	Anytime
