BY-LAW No. 720-1998

**To amend By-law No. 28-1998, being “A By-law respecting
the ‘Toronto Parking Authority’”, to facilitate the transfer of parking operations
and enforcement of regulations.**

WHEREAS, by the *City of Toronto Act, 1997 (No. 2)* and the *Municipal Act*, the Council of the City may delegate to the Toronto Parking Authority the construction, maintenance, operation and management of parking operations and facilities; and

WHEREAS City Council has previously directed that the responsibility for on-street metered parking facilities, including the setting of rates in accordance with certain set criteria, within the former Metro and Area municipalities be transferred to the Toronto Parking Authority;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. By-law No. 28-1998, being “A By-law respecting the ‘Toronto Parking Authority’ ” is amended by:

(1) Amending section 7 by:

- (a) Deleting the words “and the Community Council” from clause (d).
- (b) Adding the following clause:
 - (e) The City Solicitor may process amendments to City by-laws regulating on-street parking meters to incorporate rates set by the Parking Authority, on certification to the City Solicitor by the President of the Parking Authority that the rates have been set according to the criteria set out in clause (d).
