BY-LAW No. 777-1998

To amend further Metropolitan By-law No. 109-86 respecting maximum rates of speed on certain former Metropolitan Roads.

The Council of The City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule I of By-law No. 109-86, as amended, being a By-law "To prescribe maximum rates of speed on certain former Metropolitan Roads", is further amended by striking out the words and figures:

Frederick G. Gardiner Expressway (M.T. 200), eastbound, 100 kilometres per hour between Highway No. 427 and Grand Avenue

Frederick G. Gardiner Expressway (M.T. 200), eastbound, 60 kilometres per hour between Grand Avenue and Ellis Avenue

Frederick G. Gardiner Expressway (M.T. 200), eastbound, 90 kilometres per hour between Ellis Avenue and Leslie Street

where they occur opposite each other in Columns 1 and 2 of the said Schedule and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

(In Column 1) (In Column 2)

Frederick G. Gardiner Expressway (M.T. 200), eastbound, between a point 244 metres west of The South Kingsway and Leslie Street

90 kilometres per hour

Frederick G. Gardiner Expressway (M.T. 200), eastbound, between Highway No. 427 and the Humber River

100 kilometres per hour

2. This By-law shall be effective commencing November 8, 1998.
