BY-LAW No. 785-1998

**To dedicate certain lands on Millwood Road for
the purposes of a public highway.**

WHEREAS the lands hereinafter described have been acquired by the City of Toronto for highway purposes.

Now, therefore, the Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

- 1.** The lands described in Schedule "A", hereto attached are hereby dedicated as a public highway and declared to form part of Millwood Road.
- 2.** The said Schedule "A", hereto attached, shall form part of this By-law.
