CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 797-1998

To amend former City of Toronto Municipal Code Chapter 313, Streets and Sidewalks, with respect to the regulation of goods sold at licensed boulevard marketing areas.

WHEREAS the *Municipal Act* and the *City of Toronto Act*, 1993(No. 3) provide City Council with the authority to lease or license portions of the boulevard to the owners or occupants of abutting commercial or industrial properties and impose terms and conditions upon the use of such licensed areas; and

WHEREAS City Council has required that goods sold in licensed boulevard marketing areas be the same or similar to those sold as part of the primary use of the abutting business;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

- **1.** Chapter 313, Streets and Sidewalks, of the former City of Toronto Municipal Code is amended by:
 - (1) Amending section 313-35 by:
 - (a) Deleting clause (9) from subsection B and substituting the following:
 - (9) The owner and occupant shall ensure that no goods are displayed or sold within the licensed portion of the boulevard except goods which are the same or similar to those sold as part of the primary business carried on within the abutting premises occupied by the owner or occupant.
 - (b) Deleting subsection F and substituting the following:
 - F. Any holder of a licence under this section shall as of July 31, 1998 ensure that no goods are displayed or sold within the licensed portion of the boulevard except goods which are the same or similar to those sold as part of the primary business carried on within the abutting premises occupied by the owner or occupant.
 - (2) Amending subsection 313-47A by deleting clause (9) and substituting the following:
 - (9) As of July 31, 1998, the lessee or licensee shall ensure that no goods are displayed or sold within the licensed portion of the boulevard except goods which are the same or similar to those sold as part of the primary business carried on within the abutting premises occupied by the lessee or licensee.
