**CITY OF TORONTO**

**BY-LAW No. 809-1998**

**To amend City of York By-law No. 196-84,  
being a By-law “To Regulate traffic on City of York Roads”.**

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

**NO PARKING - SCHEDULE VIII**

**1.** That Schedule VIII of City of York By-law No. 196-84, as amended, be further amended by inserting in Columns 1, 2, 3, and 4 of said Schedule the following:

Humber Trail	East	A point 27.4 metres south Weatherell Street and a point 6 metres south thereof	Anytime

**THROUGH HIGHWAYS - SCHEDULE XVIII**

**2.** That Schedule XVIII of City of York By-law No. 196-84, as amended, be further amended by deleting in Columns 1 and 2 of the said Schedule the following:

Column 1 <u>Highway</u>	Column 2 <u>Between</u>
Glenholme Ave.	The south limit of Earnscliffe Road and south limit of City of York
Glenholme Ave.	The north limit of Earnscliffe Road and south limit of O’Leary Avenue

**THROUGH HIGHWAYS - SCHEDULE XVIII**

**3.** That Schedule XVIII of City of York By-law No. 196-84, as amended, be further amended by inserting in Columns 1 and 2 of the said Schedule the following:

Column 1 <u>Highway</u>	Column 2 <u>Between</u>
Glenholme Avenue	The south limit Millerson Avenue and south limit O’Leary Avenue

STOP SIGNS - SCHEDULE XIX

4. That Schedule XIX of City of York By-law No. 196-84, as amended, be further amended by inserting in Column 1 and 2 of the said Schedule the following:

Column 1 <u>Intersection</u>	Column 2 <u>Stop Streets</u>
Conway Avenue and Glenholme Avenue	Conway Avenue for westbound traffic
Glenholme Avenue and Conway Avenue	Glenholme Avenue for northbound traffic
Earnscliffe Road and Glenholme Avenue	Earnscliffe Road for westbound traffic
