CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 814-1998

To authorize the construction of certain asphalt and curbing works as local improvements on Council's initiative.

WHEREAS subsection 7(1)(b) of the Local Improvement Act authorizes Council to pass a by-law to undertake a work as a local improvement, subject to notice being given and no petition against the work undertaken being received;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

- 1. The construction of asphalt pavements with curbs be undertaken as local improvements in the following locations:
 - (a) Alfred Avenue from Dudley Avenue to the west end;
 - (b) Greenfield Avenue from Dudley Avenue to 62 metres west;
 - (c) Maplehurst Avenue from Willowdale Avenue to the west end;
 - (d) Stafford Road from Betty Ann Drive to Ellerslie Avenue; and
 - (e) Wimpole Drive from Bayview Avenue to Forest Heights Boulevard; and
 - (f) York Downs Drive from Almore Avenue to Yeomans Road.
