BY-LAW No. 841-1998

**To amend further Metropolitan By-law No. 32-92, respecting the regulation of traffic
on former Metropolitan Roads.**

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule IX (No Stopping) of Metropolitan By-law No. 32-92, as amended, is further amended by striking out the words and figures:

Jarvis Street (M.T. 31)	West	Carlton Street and Charles Street East	7:30 a.m. to 9:30 a.m. and 3:30 p.m. to 6:30 p.m. Monday to Friday except Public Holidays
Jarvis Street (M.T. 31)	West	Lake Shore Boulevard and a point 56.5 metres south of Carlton Street	7:30 a.m. to 9:30 a.m. and 3:30 p.m. to 6:30 p.m. Monday to Friday except Public Holidays

where they occur opposite each other in Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the said Schedule and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

(In Column 1)	(In Column 2)	(In Column 3)	(In Column 4)
Jarvis Street (M.T. 31)	West	Charles Street East and Lake Shore Boulevard	7:30 a.m. to 9:30 a.m. and 3:30 p.m. to 6:30 p.m. Monday to Friday except Public Holidays

2. Schedule XI (No Standing) of Metropolitan By-law No. 32-92, as amended, is further amended by striking out the following words and figures:

Jarvis Street (M.T. 31)	West	A point 30.5 metres south of Carlton Street and a point 26 metres further south thereof	Anytime

where they occur opposite each other in Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the said Schedule.
