BY-LAW No. 882-1998

**To appoint Claire Tucker-Reid as manager of certain City vessels
and as signing officer to effect her registration in that capacity.**

WHEREAS the Canada Shipping Act requires that the name and address of the managing owner of every ship registered at a port in Canada, or the name of the person to whom the management of the ship is entrusted on behalf of the owner, shall be registered at the custom-house of that port:

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Claire Tucker-Reid, General Manager, Parks and Recreation Division of the City of Toronto, is hereby appointed as the person to whom the management of the following City vessels is entrusted:

“Thomas Rennie”

“Sam McBride”

“William Inglis”

“Trillium”

“Ongiara”

2. Claire Tucker-Reid is hereby appointed to sign all documents necessary to secure her registration as such Manager under the Canada Shipping Act.

3. By-law No. 48-96, a By-law “To appoint B. Raymond Biggart as Manager of certain Metropolitan vessels and as signing officer to effect his registration in that capacity”, is hereby repealed.
