CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 911-1998

To amend By-law No. 28-1998, being “A By-law respecting the ‘Toronto Parking Authority’”, to allow for the management and use of on-street parking machine facilities.

WHEREAS, by the *City of Toronto Act, 1997 (No. 2)* and the *Municipal Act*, the Council of the City may delegate to the Toronto Parking Authority the construction, maintenance, operation and management of parking operations and facilities; and

WHEREAS City Council has previously directed that the responsibility for on-street metered parking facilities, including the setting of rates in accordance with certain set criteria, within the former Metro and Area municipalities be transferred to the Toronto Parking Authority; and

WHEREAS City Council wishes to delegate to the Toronto Parking Authority the ability to manage the use of parking machines as well as meters, set rates for the use of parking machines according to the criteria as set by City Council and replace meters with machines or machines with meters as appropriate;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. By-law No. 28-1998, being “A By-law respecting the ‘Toronto Parking Authority’ ” is amended by:

(1) Amending section 7 by:

- (a) Deleting the words “metered parking facilities” in the opening paragraph and substituting the words “parking meter and parking machine facilities”.
- (b) Deleting clause (c) and substituting the following:
 - (c) Except as provided in clause (d), only City Council shall pass by-laws for the purposes of regulating the installation and operation of on-street parking meters and parking machines, including the setting of rates for meters or machines.
- (c) Adding after the words “parking meters” where they appear in clause (d) the words “or parking machines”.
- (d) Deleting clause (e) and substituting the following:
 - (e) The City Solicitor may process amendments to City by-laws regulating on-street parking meters and parking machines to:

- (i) incorporate rates set by the Parking Authority, on certification to the City Solicitor by the President of the Parking Authority that the rates have been set according to the criteria set out in clause (d); and
- (ii) replace parking meters with parking machines or parking machines with parking meters, on certification to the City Solicitor by the President of the Parking Authority that the replacement has been agreed to by the Ward Councillors for the Ward in which the parking meters or parking machines are located.
