CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 928-1998

To amend City of North York By-law No. 7625.

WHEREAS authority is given to Council by Section 34 of the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990, c.P. 13, as amended, to pass this By-law; and whereas Council of the City of Toronto has provided adequate information to the public and has held at least one public meeting in accordance with the Planning Act;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedules "B" and "C" of By-law No. 7625 of the former City of North York are amended in accordance with Schedule "1" to this By-law.
2. Section 64.37 of By-law No. 7625 of the former City of North York is amended by adding the following subsection:

"64.37(14) O1(14)

PERMITTED USES

- (a) The only permitted uses shall be a public park, a public playground, and a play lot.

EXCEPTION REGULATIONS

- (b) The maximum gross floor area shall be 0.0 m².

3. Section 64.36(14) of By-law No. 7625 of the former City of North York is deleted.
