BY-LAW No. 964-1998

**To amend the former City of Toronto Municipal Code Ch. 400,
Traffic and Parking, respecting Bremner Boulevard.**

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Municipal Code Chapter 400, Traffic and Parking, of the former City of Toronto is amended as follows:

A By inserting in Schedule I (One-Way Highways) in §400-54, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1)	(In Column 2)	(In Column 3)	(In Column 4)
Bremner Boulevard (north-south leg)	Lake Shore Boulevard West and the east-west leg of Bremner Boulevard	Anytime	From south to north

B By inserting in Schedule IV (Stop Intersections) in §400-57, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1)	(In Column 2)
North-South leg of Bremner Boulevard and the East-West leg of Bremner Boulevard	North-South leg of Bremner Boulevard (northbound)

C By inserting in Schedule XXIII (No Parking Certain Times) in §400-76, the following in alphabetical order by street name:

(In Column 1)	(In Column 2)	(In Column 3)	(In Column 4)
Bremner Boulevard	Both	Lake Shore Boulevard West and York Street	Anytime

2. Section 1 of this By-law does not come into effect until By-law No. 959-1998, being “A By-law to layout and dedicate certain land for public highway purposes and to name that land to form part of Bremner Boulevard.”, comes into effect.
