BY-LAW No. 967-1998

**To amend further Metropolitan Toronto By-law No. 20-85, a by-law
“Respecting the licensing, regulating and governing of trades, callings, businesses
and occupations in the Metropolitan Area”, a by-law of the former
Municipality of Metropolitan Toronto.**

WHEREAS By-law No. 806-1998 was enacted by City Council at its meeting of October 28, 29 and 30, 1998, further amending By-law No. 20-85, a by-law “Respecting the licensing, regulating and governing of trades, callings, businesses and occupations in the Metropolitan Area”, as amended, a by-law of the former Municipality of Metropolitan Toronto; and

WHEREAS the said By-law No. 806-1998 contains typographical errors;

The Council of The City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Section 2 of By-law No. 806-1998, a by-law further amending By-law No. 20-85, a by-law “Respecting the licensing, regulating and governing of trades, callings, businesses and occupations in the Metropolitan Area”, as amended, a by-law of the former Municipality of Metropolitan Toronto, is amended by deleting the numbers 64 and 65 wherever they appear therein and inserting in lieu thereof the numbers 65 and 66, respectively, such that section 2 of By-law No. 806-1998 reads as follows:

2. Section 2 of By-law No. 20-85, as amended, is further amended by adding the following subsections:

2(65) every owner of a holistic centre;

2(66) every person other than a person licensed pursuant to subsection (65) hereof, who provides or offers holistic services.

2. Subsection 1(2) of Schedule 43 to By-law No. 20-85, as amended, is further amended by deleting the reference to number 65 therein and inserting in lieu thereof the number 66, such that the said subsection reads as follows:

1. (2) “Holistic Practitioner” means a person licensed or required to be licensed under subsection 2(66) of this By-law.

3. This By-law shall be deemed to have come into force on October 30, 1998.
