**CITY OF TORONTO**

**BY-LAW No. 6-1999**

**To establish Part of Clyde Road as a municipal highway.**

WHEREAS the City has acquired certain lands as hereinafter described and the Council of the City deems it appropriate and necessary to accept the said lands as a Public Highway; and

WHEREAS Subsection 1(a) of Section 297, of the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter M.45 provides that the Council of every municipality may pass by-laws for establishing and laying out highways; and

WHEREAS Subsection 111 of Section 210, of the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter M.45 provides that by-laws may be passed by the Councils of local municipalities to provide for surveying, settling and marking the boundary lines of highways and giving names to them;

Now, therefore, the Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

**1.** The lands described as Part of Lot 4 in Concession 1, designated as Part 1 on Reference Plan 66R-18104, in the City of Toronto (formerly City of Scarborough), more particularly described in Schedule attached hereto, which forms part of this By-law, are hereby established and laid out as a public highway within the City to be known as Clyde Road.

**2.** All By-laws presently in force with respect to highways and streets shall apply to the said highway created under this By-law.
