CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 26-1999

**To designate the portion of Draper Street between Wellington Street West
and Front Street West as a Heritage Conservation District.**

WHEREAS the Council of the former City of Toronto, at its meeting of September 22, 1997, adopted Clause 7 of Neighbourhoods Committee Report No. 12., authorized the passing of a by-law under Section 40 of the Ontario Heritage Act, defining the portion of Draper Street between Wellington Street West and Front Street West as an area to be examined for future designation as a heritage conservation district; and

WHEREAS City Council, at its meeting of September 22, 1997, therefore passed By-law No. 1997-0494, defining the study area; and

WHEREAS a heritage study of the area was subsequently conducted; and

WHEREAS the *City of Toronto Act, 1997* provides that every by-law or resolution of the Council of the former City of Toronto in force before Scarborough was dissolved on January 1, 1998 shall be deemed to be a by-law or resolution of the City of Toronto;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

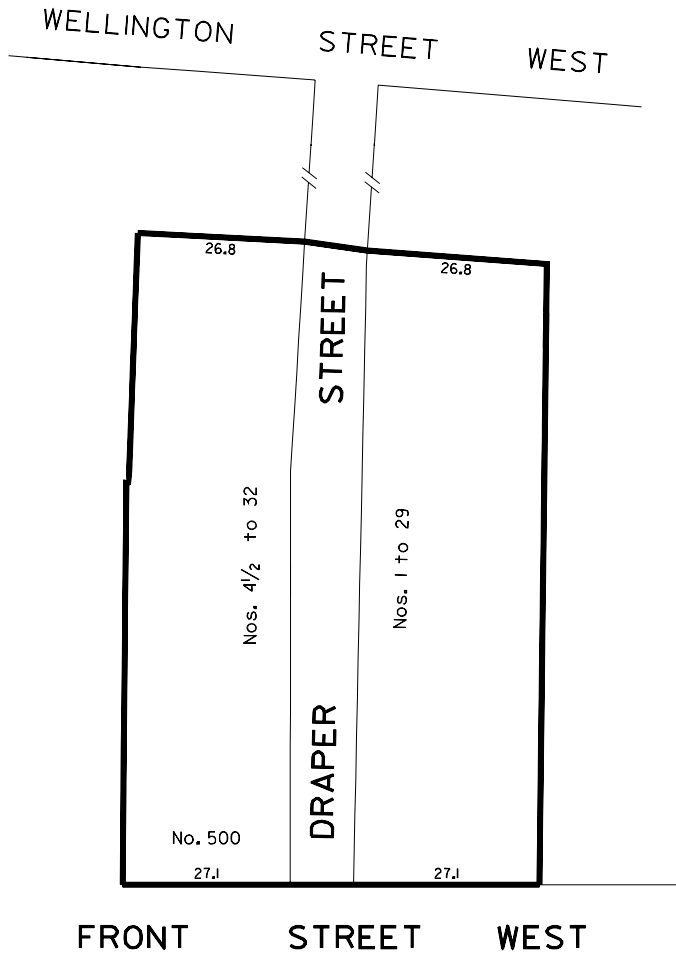
1. The area within the heavy lines shown on the map attached to and forming part of this by-law, is designated as a heritage conservation district under Part V of the Ontario Heritage Act, R.S.O. 1990, chapter 0.18, as amended.
2. This by-law shall come into force upon approval by the Ontario Municipal Board.

ENACTED AND PASSED this 4th day of February, A.D. 1999.

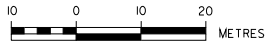
