BY-LAW No. 30-1999

To amend By-law No. 81-89, entitled “A By-law to regulate the height and description of lawful fences”, being a by-law of the former Borough of East York.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule “1” of By-law No. 81-89, as amended, being a by-law of the former Borough of East York, is further amended by inserting in Columns “A”, “B” and “C” of said Schedule the following:

Column A	Column B	Column C
47 Don Valley Drive	Section 2.1.4 sets a maximum fence height of 0.9 metres in a front yard.	Variance from Section 2.1.4 to allow a fence in the front yard of 47 Don Valley Drive, said fence having a length of approximately 9.15 metres, extending from the front, east corner of the house and having a height varying from 1.75 metres to 2.13 metres from grade, said fence terminating at a point approximately 2.90 metres from the curb of the travelled portion of the roadway of Don Valley Drive.
