BY-LAW No. 50-1999

To amend further By-law No. 271, a by-law “To prohibit parking on certain sides of certain highways”, being a by-law of the former Borough of East York.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule I of By-law No. 271, a By-law “To prohibit parking on certain sides of certain highways”, as amended, being a by-law of the former Borough of East York, is further amended by inserting in Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the said Schedule, between the words “Muriel Avenue” and “Rosevear Avenue” where they appear in Column 1 of the said Schedule, the following:

Column 1 Highway	Column 2 Side	Column 3 Between	Column 4 Prohibited Months
Randolph Road	East	A point 88.5 metres south of McRae Drive and Markham Avenue	May, July, September and November
Randolph Road	West	A point 67.5 metres south of McRae Drive and Markham Avenue	January, February, March, April, June, August, October and December

2. This by-law shall come into force on the date of its enactment.
