CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 71-1999

To amend further Metropolitan By-law No. 32-92, respecting the regulation of traffic on former Metropolitan Roads.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule VIII (No Parking) of Metropolitan By-law No. 32-92, as amended, is further amended by striking out the words and figures:

Eglinton Avenue South West (M.T. 18)	Strathearn Road and a point 30.5 metres east of Glen Cedar Road	7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.
Eglinton Avenue South West (M.T. 18)	A point 42.8 metres east of Glen Cedar Road and a point approximately 40.0 metres east of Rostrevor Road	7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.

where they occur opposite each other in Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the said Schedule and inserting in lieu thereof the following:
