**CITY OF TORONTO**

**BY-LAW No. 75-1999**

**To further amend Metropolitan Toronto By-law No. 20-85, a by-law  
“Respecting the licensing, regulating and governing  
of trades, callings, businesses and occupations  
in the Metropolitan Area”, a by-law of the former Municipality  
of Metropolitan Toronto.**

WHEREAS By-law No. 448-1998 was enacted by Council on July 10, 1998 amending By-law 20-85 of the former Municipality of Metropolitan Toronto to require the licensing of vendors of alcoholic beverages and the establishment and operation of a liquor and wine bottle deposit and return system as a condition of licensing; and

WHEREAS the Minister of Municipal Affairs and Housing, on December 18, 1998, filed a regulation prohibiting municipalities from imposing conditions of licensing respecting containers for alcoholic beverages; and

WHEREAS the Ministry of the Environment has further indicated that the City of Toronto will be eligible to receive its share of annual Blue Box funding under a voluntary industry funding plan, including funding from the Liquor Control Board of Ontario, if it repeals its by-law imposing licensing requirements for a liquor and wine bottle deposit and return system;

The Council of The City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

**1.** By-law No. 20-85, as amended, a by-law "Respecting the licensing, regulating and governing of trades, callings, businesses and occupations in the Metropolitan Area", a by-law of the former Municipality of Metropolitan Toronto, is further amended by deleting subsections 1(1a) and 1(49), being definitions of “alcoholic beverage” and “vendor of alcoholic beverages”, and deleting subsection 2(64).

**2.** Schedule 1 of By-law No. 20-85, as amended, relating to the annual fees for licences, is further amended by deleting the following under the columns indicated:

Column 1 Description of Licence	Column 2 Fee \$	Column 3 Expiry Date
Vendor of Alcoholic Beverages for each sale location	\$501.00	December 31st

**3.** By-law No. 20-85, as amended, is further amended by deleting Schedule 42.
