BY-LAW No. 107-1999

**To amend By-law No. 32852 of the City of North York in respect of Designation
By-law "Oakley" Property - Philip Edward Brent - 288 Old Yonge Street
(Formerly 264 Old Yonge Street) - North York Centre South.**

WHEREAS by By-law No. 32852, and pursuant to the *Ontario Heritage Act*, R.S.O. 1990, the Council of the former City of North York designated the residence known as "Oakley", 288 Old Yonge Street, as being of architectural and historical value or interest; and

WHEREAS the parcel of land on which "Oakley" is located has been subdivided by registration of Plan of Subdivision No. 66M-2322; and

WHEREAS "Oakley" is now located on Lot 16 on Plan 66M-2322; and

WHEREAS the legal description of the "Oakley" parcel set out in By-law No. 32852 requires amendment;

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. By-law No. 32852 is hereby amended by replacing its Schedule "A" with the Schedule "A" attached hereto.
