CITY OF TORONTO

BY-LAW No. 139-1999

To amend further Metropolitan By-law No. 32-92, respecting the regulation of traffic on former Metropolitan Roads.

The Council of the City of Toronto HEREBY ENACTS as follows:

1. Schedule VIII (No Parking) of Metropolitan By-law No. 32-92, as amended, is further amended by inserting the following words and figures in Columns 1, 2, 3 and 4 of the said Schedule:

Avenue Road/University Avenue (M.T. 25)	Both	Front Street West and Lawrence Avenue West	7:00 a.m to 7:00 p.m. Monday to Friday
Bloor Street/Danforth Avenue (M.T. 10)	Both	Jane Street and Danforth Road	7:00 a.m to 7:00 p.m. Monday to Friday
Eglinton Avenue (M.T. 18)	Both	W.R. Allen Road and Brentcliffe Road	7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. Monday to Friday
Yonge Street (M.T. 29)	Both	Front Street and Steeles Avenue	7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. Monday to Friday

2. This By-law shall be effective commencing from 12:01 a.m. on the first day from and after April 13, 1999, of a Toronto Transit Commission strike or lockout affecting all or a portion of transit service by the Toronto Transit Commission to the earlier of:

- (i) 12:01 a.m. of the first day following the return to normal transit operation, and
- (ii) June 9, 1999.

3. Where any prohibition contained in this By-law conflicts with any pre-existing prohibition in Schedule VIII of Metropolitan Toronto By-law No. 32-92, the prohibitions in this By-law shall prevail.
